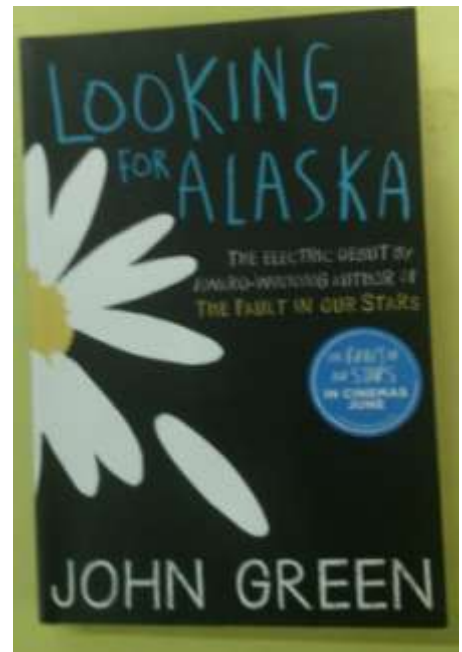

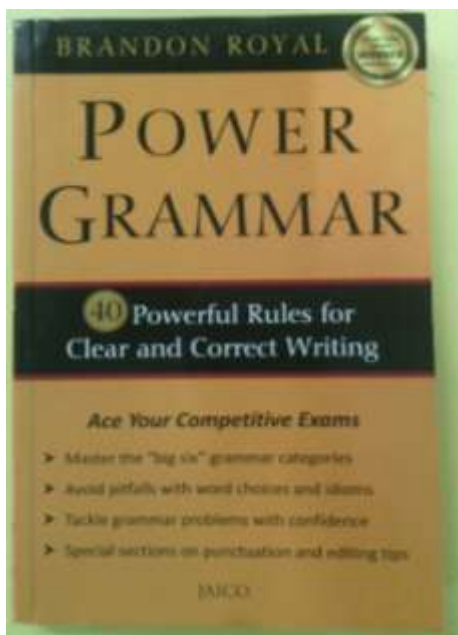


## POWER GRAMMAR

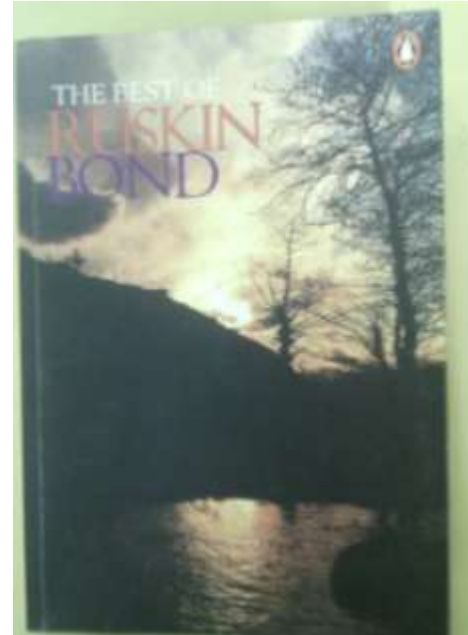


## THE BEST OF RUSKIN BOND

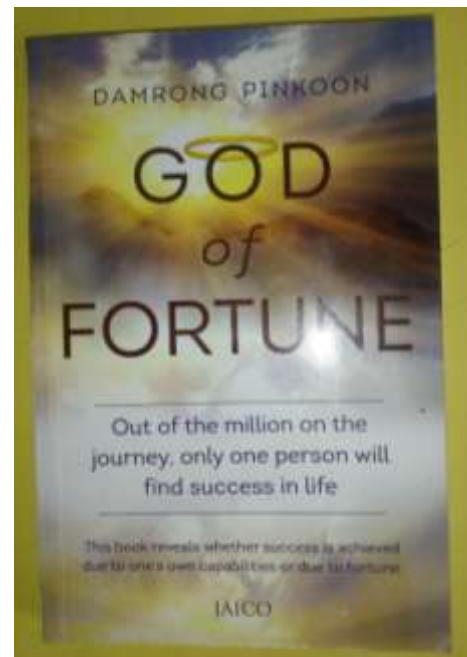

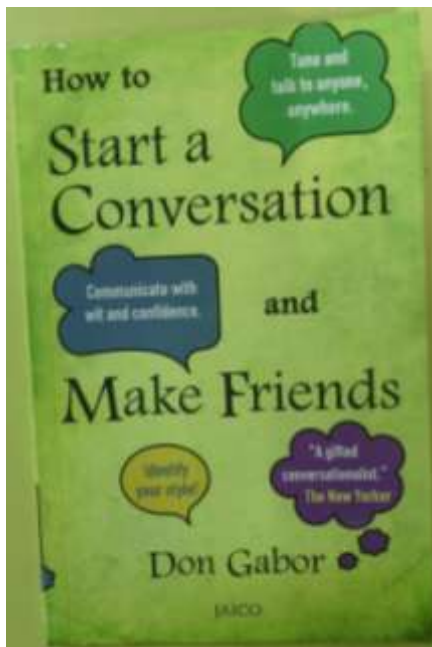
## GOD OF FORTUNE

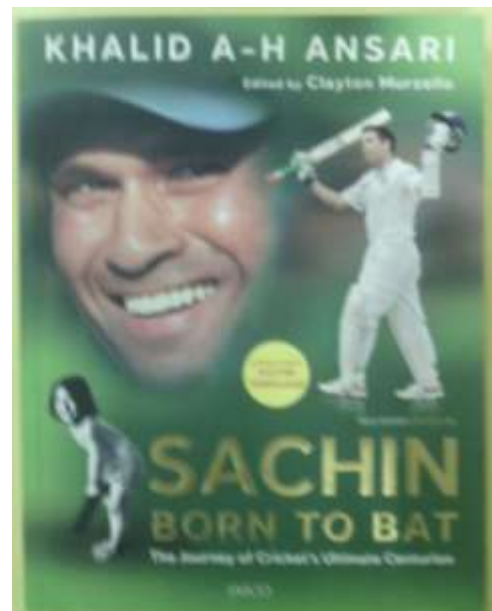

## SACHIN: BORN TO BAT

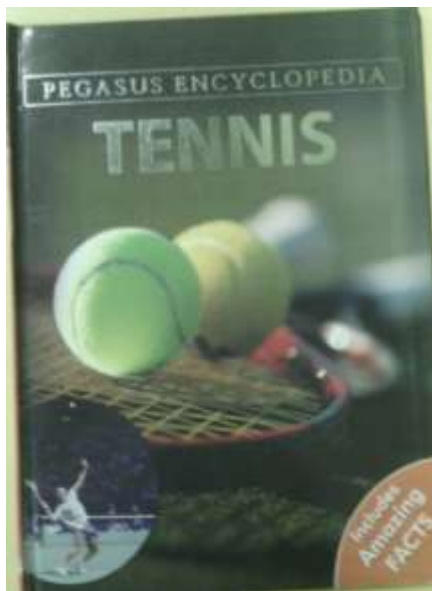

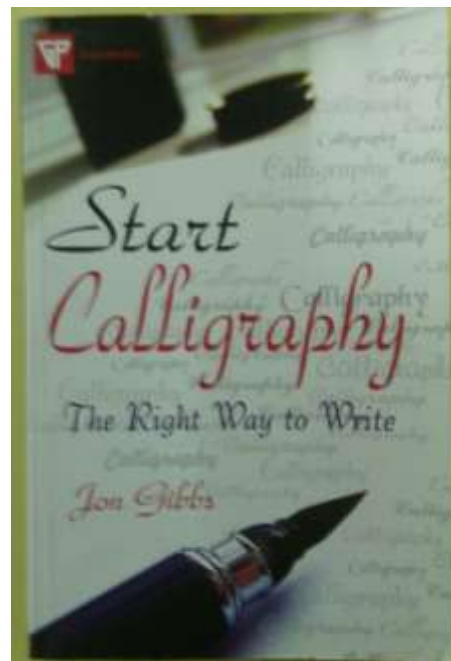

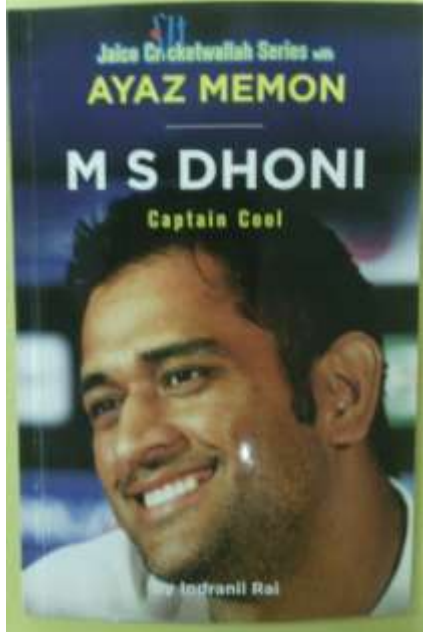
## START CALLIGRAPHY

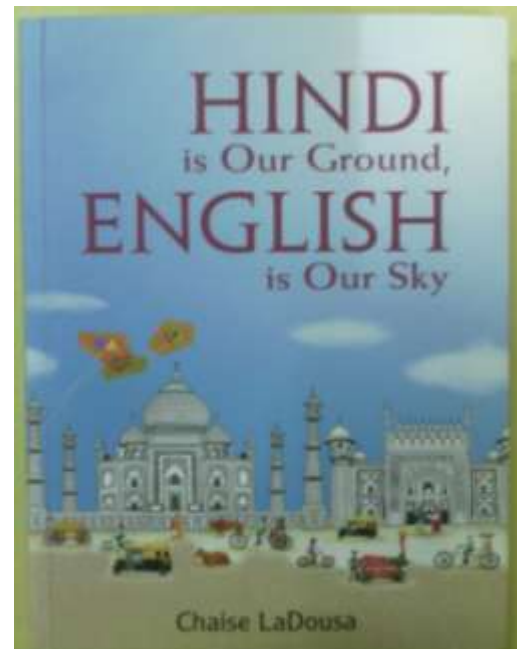

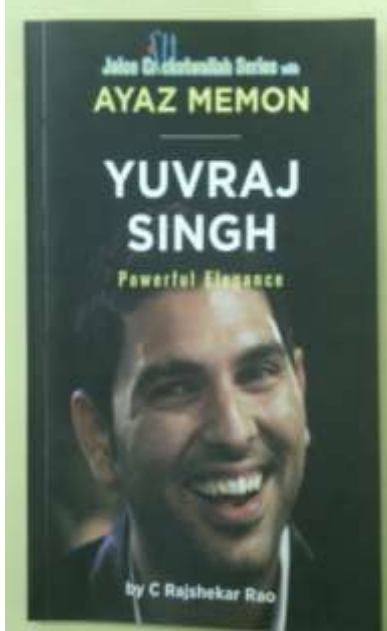
## HINDI IS OUR GROUND ENGLISH IS OUR SKY
