DAY 1 NEW DELHI / McLEOD GANJ (-/-/-)

20h00 Students to report at school for overnight coach transfer to McLeod Ganj.

DAY 2 ARRIVAL IN McLEOD GANJ - TSUGLAGKHANG COMPLEX, MOMO MAKING SESSION(B/L/D)

09h00 Approx. at this time you will arrive at McLeod Ganj and check in to hotel for 2 nights' stay. Post breakfast the morning is at leisure to unwind.

Lunch will be at the hotel.

After lunch you will visit Tsuglagkhang Complex, which is the seat of the Tibetan government-inexile is in McLeod Ganj. The complex has Dalai Lama's residence, Tibet Museum, Tsuglagkhang Temple, Kalachakra Temple and Namgyal Gompa. You will feel the ambiance, which is warm and collegial. Wistful sketches of the Potala Palace hang beside paintings that depict scriptural stories and fierce Tibetan deities.

17h00 Thereafter, proceed for an exciting momo making session under the supervision of Tibetan chef.

#### DAY 3 McLEOD GANJ -BAHL VILLAGE, TIBETAN CHILDREN VILLAGE, CUD PROJECT (B/L/D)

06h00 Wakeup call, wash & change

O6h45 Assemble in the lobby for milk, tea/coffee & cookies. During this time ULeaP Thought of the Day and the day's program will be discussed.

07h00 Depart for Bahl village (approx. 1 hour trek). En-route stop for birding, see a Himachali village house, and a Clean Upper Dharamshala (CUD) initiative of cleaning the trail of litter. Here you will be passing amidst the forest and towards the end take the trail on foot. The route exposes you to vast variety in flora of the region. Picnic breakfast will be served at Bahl Village.

10h30 Proceed to visit the Tibetan Children's Village (TCV) for interaction with destitute Tibetan children in exile, as well as for hundreds of those escaping from Tibet every year.

Lunch will be at one of the popular cafés.

15h00 Visit the Clean Upper Dharamshala (CUD) project office to understand their initiatives to keep Upper Dharamshala clean & free of litter and also see some of their recycled products. Students will have an opportunity to try their hand at making some of the products.

ULeaP reflection is followed by traditional sit-down Kangri Dham dinner.

# DAY 4 McLEOD GANJ - ST JOHN IN THE WILDERNESS, KANGRA FORT, DEPARTURE FOR DELHI (B/L/D)

Breakfast is at the hotel.

08h30 Visit St. John in the Wilderness, located within walking proximity of McLeod Ganj, is an Anglican church dedicated to John the Baptist built in 1852 at Forsyth Gunj. Set amidst a deodar forest and built in neo-Gothic architecture, the surrounding forests are a great way to showcase Himalayan flora. The Church structure survived the 1905 Kangra earthquake, one of the most devastating calamities which destroyed many buildings in the area.

12h00 Check out of the hotel and have lunch at one of the popular cafés.

Post lunch you will visit Kangra fort, which was built, by royal Rajput family of Kangra State (the Katoch dynasty), which traces its origins to the ancient Trigarta Kingdom, mentioned in the Mahabharata epic. It is the largest fort in the Himalayas and probably the oldest dated fort in India. Enter the fort through a small courtyard enclosed between two gates which were built during the Sikh period, from here a long and narrow passage leads up to the top of the fort, through the Ahani and Amiri Darwaza (gate). About 500 feet from the outer gate the passage turns round at a very sharp angle and passes through the Jehangiri Darwaza. Enjoy the historic beauty and visit the temples of Lakshmi Narayan and the Sitlamata, which have elaborate decorations on ceilings and exquisite carvings to delight you

ULeaP reflection is followed by transfer back to Delhi. Packed dinner will be served on-board the coach.
