

RULES FOR STUDENTS

Being on an Explorars program is a privilege and probably some of your best days of your entire school years. All privileges come with responsibilities. Here are some basic rules and responsibilities for young travelers on the Explorars program. All rules are only extensions what you must be following in your school. Remember, you will be representing your school and hence discipline and good conduct is to be followed at all times.

Bus discipline: Do not litter the bus (wrappers and covers should be dropped into garbage bags provided in the bus) and ensure that your belongings are with you at all times. Do not play loud music or walk around when the bus is in motion, you will disturb the driver and run the risk of hurting yourself should you fall down.

Stay together: Listen carefully when your Program Director (PD) or the Teacher In-charge gives instructions about the plan for the day and the group you are assigned to, teacher, or your program buddy. Don't wander off on your own. Break this rule and you could end up with the teacher as your program buddy! ©

Respect Program Directors and Experts: Pay attention to the instructions, ULeaP thoughts and Expert's speeches and presentations. PDs have a big responsibility, watching after many students at one time and ensuring the program runs smoothly. Explorars' programs always include sessions with experts who take out time to share wisdom with you. Be attentive.

Respect nature: Explorars programs bring you in close contact with nature. Be mindful, do not make noise, touch or tease animals so that you can enjoy nature's beauty. Just follow your Naturalist and PD's instructions, if he wants you to touch or feel something he will instruct you.

Don't roughhouse: On a Explorars program you may visit a factory containing equipments with moving parts, or a museum with priceless arts and exhibits. Please be alert and cautious so that you do not cause damage to the exhibits or hurt yourself in the bargain.

Punctuality: This is of utmost importance on our programs as all of them are time sensitive. You must be on time for all the activities and must ensure that you remain punctual throughout the program.

Night curfew: Please respect the night curfew timings, which will be set for your own safety and security. Random but regular room checks will be conducted by the teachers. Visitors or group members of the opposite sex are not allowed into your rooms. After lights-out you must not leave your rooms except in case of an emergency in which you must immediately contact the Teacher In-charge.

Mobile phone: Explorars programs strictly follow a No-Mobiles policy. However, the final decision rests with the school. If you are travelling with your mobile phone, they must be switched off as a courtesy to the group as well as to the PDs and Experts assigned to speak on the program. If you must make a call, please approach the Teacher In-charge who will help you move away from your group.

Zero tolerance: Explorars has zero tolerance towards bullying, smoking, alcohol and consumption of intoxicants. Any student found breaking this rule will immediately be removed from the program and sent back home at his cost.
