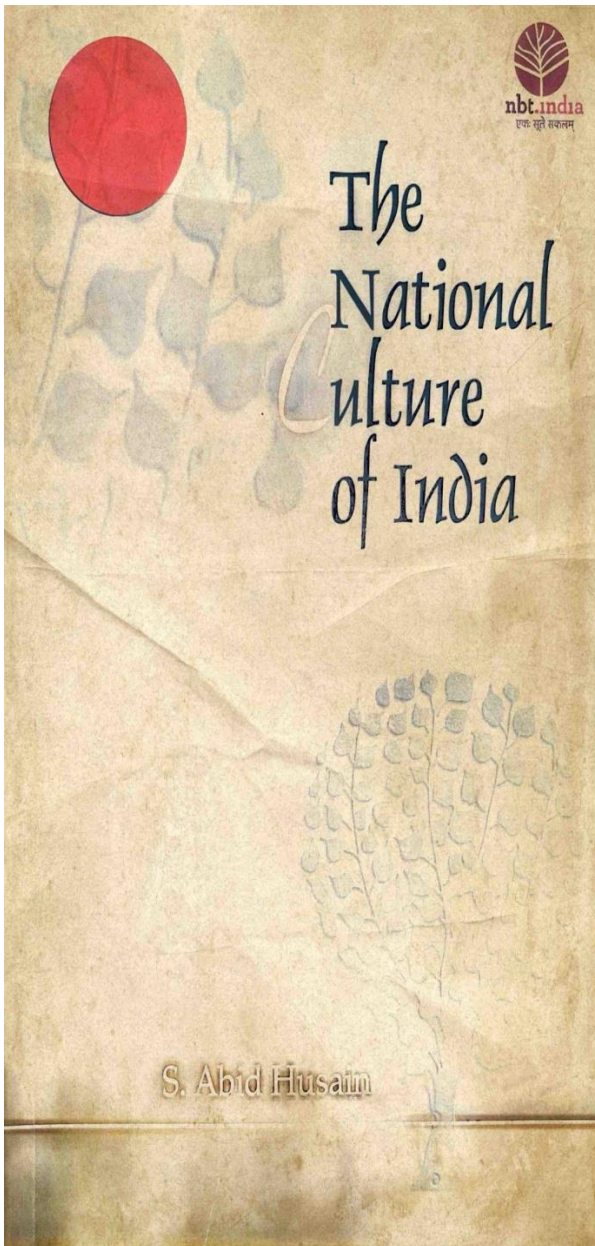




# 11) TITLE – The National Culture of India

By - S. Abid Hussain

This book is a learned exposition of the theory that amidst the great diversity in every walk of life in India, there exists an underlying unity. To elucidate his thesis, the author has made a chronological survey of Indian history and the movements that have shaped the country. He has concluded by enumerating the various fissiparous tendencies present today, but still sees hope in the future.

Abid Husain (1896-1978) was Professor of Philosophy and Literature at Jamia Millia, New Dehli, during 1926-56 and then Professor Emeritus, Jamia Millia. He wrote over forty books including *Indian Nationalism and Indian culture* (3 volumes), *The Way of Gandhi and Nehru*, *The Destiny of Indian Muslims*, besides various translations from English and German. The original edition of this book in Urdu received the Sahitya Akademi Award in 1956 and in 1957 Dr. Husain was awarded the Padma Bhushan.
