my life would have been bland, monotonous, and lonely.

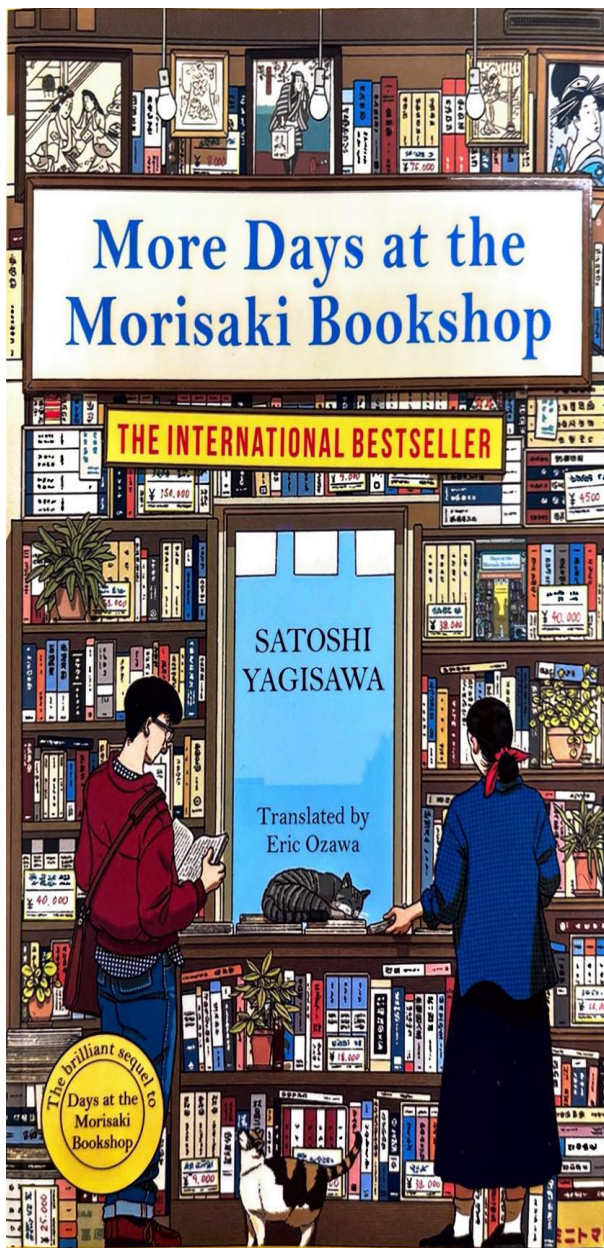
The Morisaki Bookshop is precious to me.

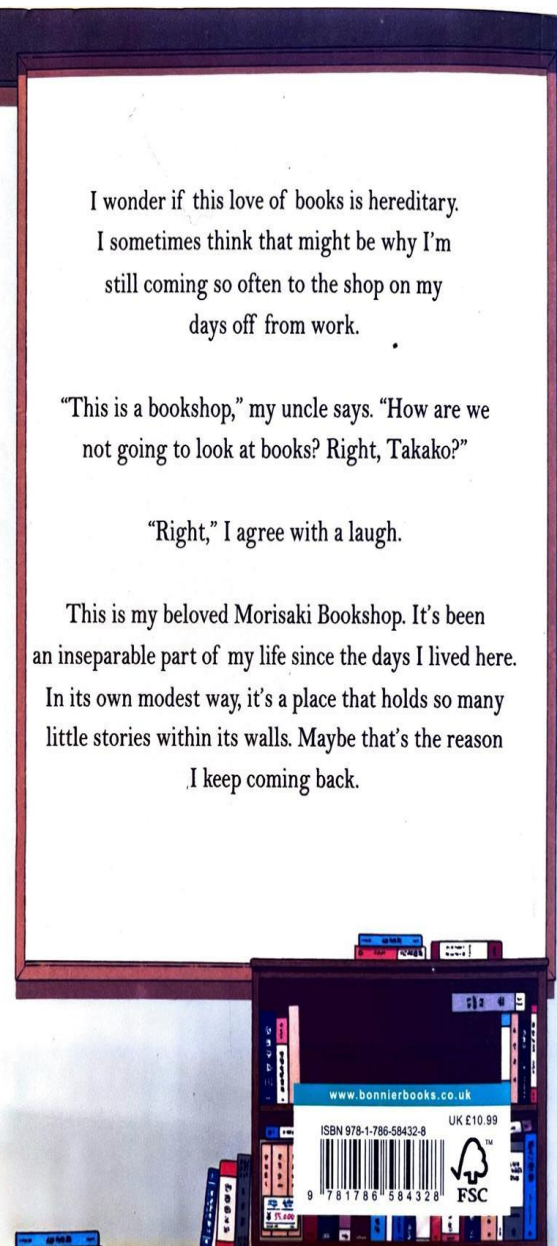


I wonder if this love of books is hereditary.

not going to look at books? Right, Takako?"

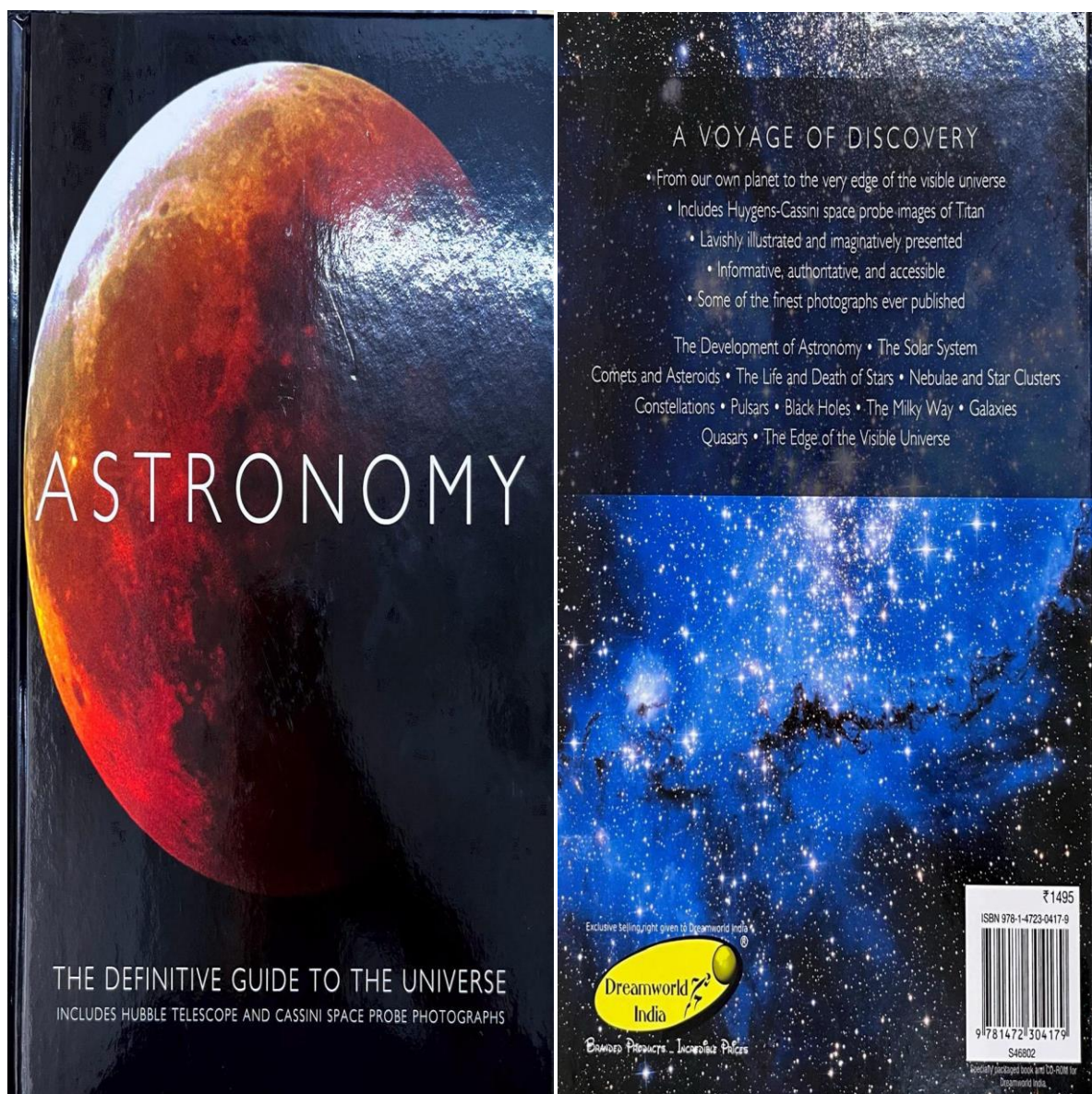
"Right," I agree with a laugh.

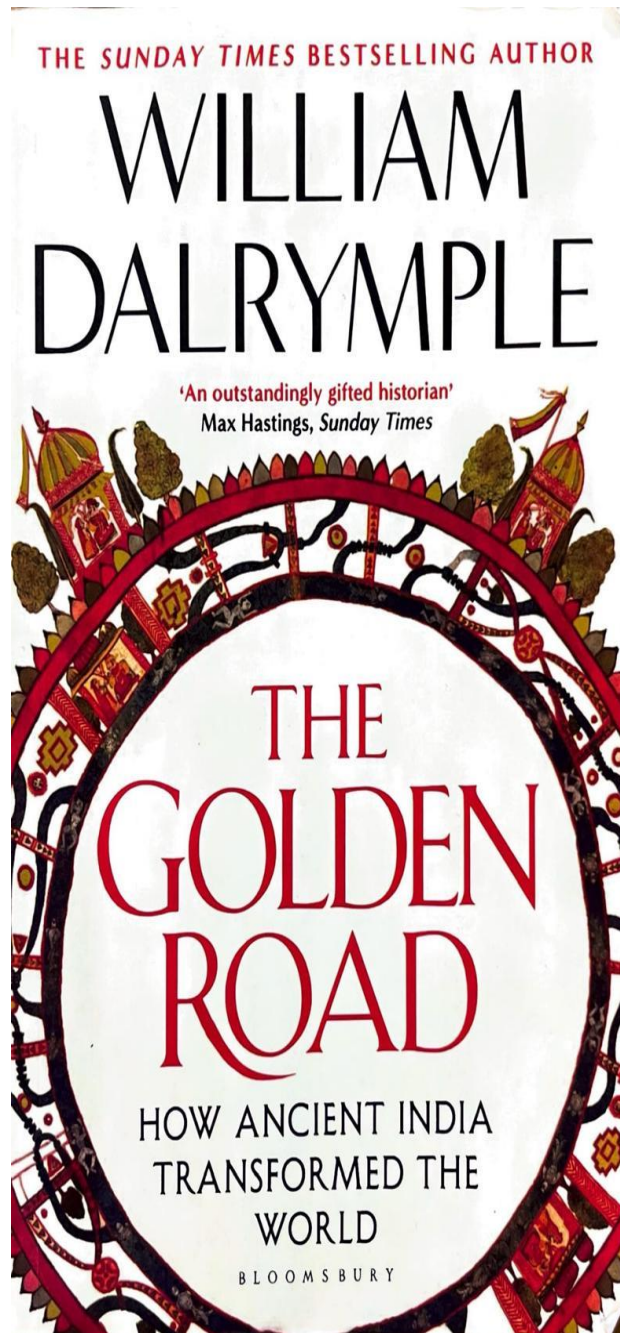
