

Ali Nagvi was a lawyer, a responsible citizen and a friend of ITIHAAS. In 2013, he was hit by a car while crossing a busy intersection in South Delhi, leaving him with injuries that proved to be fatal. It was a case of hit and run. Ali was in his early 30's when he died. It was after his death that we at ITIHAAS decided to create a programme that builds awareness and understanding of our legal system as well as our role as individuals in civil society. This is a five day moving programme, from 10.00 am to 2.00 pm at different venues. The Parliament street police station, the courts, The Pradhanmantri Sangrahalaya, Studio Safdar to name some. Exact locations will be shared prior to the programme. It aims at building responsible citizenship. An on-ground understanding of our rights and duties as citizens. They will be given tasks to complete, films to watch, workbooks to work in and reports to write, amongst many other things. They will be closely supervised by an ITIHAAS Team leader at all times.
