This programme will run from Sunday 25th May to Sunday 1st June 2025, from 10.00 am to 2.00 pm. The students report at the National Gandhi Museum. They will work within the museum premises, closely supervised by an ITIHAAS Team leader, in groups, in pairs and individually.

In his autobiography, Gandhi states that, he was a mediocre student and barely got through the multiplication tables. He was shy and avoided company and literally ran back from school so that no one spoke to him. Mohandas had very poor handwriting and he did not like sports, specially gymnastics. He enjoyed long walks but no sports !

During this programme, students will explore how the young child "Monya" grew to be the "Mahatma". They will understand the life and relevance of Gandhi. They will be given tasks to complete, films to watch, workbooks to work in and reports to write, amongst many other things.

They will meet professionals in connected fields. They will also visit Rashtrapati Bhawan during the programme. For the culmination they will curate a gallery walk for which friends and families will be invited. A certificate will be given on successful completion of the programme.
