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This programme will run from Sunday 8th June to Sunday 15th June 2025, from 10.00 am to 2.00 pm. Students report at the National Museum. They will work within the museum premises, closely supervised by museum experts, in groups, in pairs and individually.

Students will work on objects that interest them within defined galleries, create story boards, audio guides and /or activity kits to be used with visitors to the museum. They will be given tasks to complete, films to watch, workbooks to work in and reports to write, amongst many other things.

They will meet professionals in fields connected to museology such as curators, conservators and archivists. For the culmination they will work as “Yuva Saathis” A certificate will be given on successful completion of the programme.

Marking 10 years of our annual Summer Internship Programme at the National Museum, ITIHAAS was invited to put up a special exhibition at the National Museum, geared towards interactive heritage education in museum spaces where the ex-interns were given an opportunity to showcase their work.
