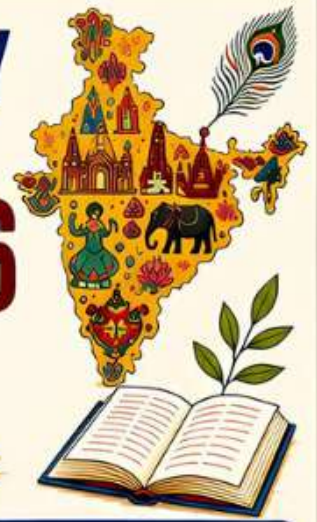

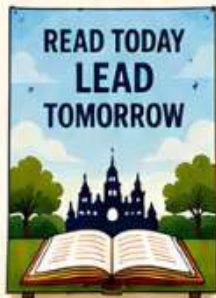
1 CARTOON STRIPS / COMIC CREATION

- ✓ Proper name slip with details to be attached.
- ✓ Reading and Indian cultural values should remain central to every activity.
